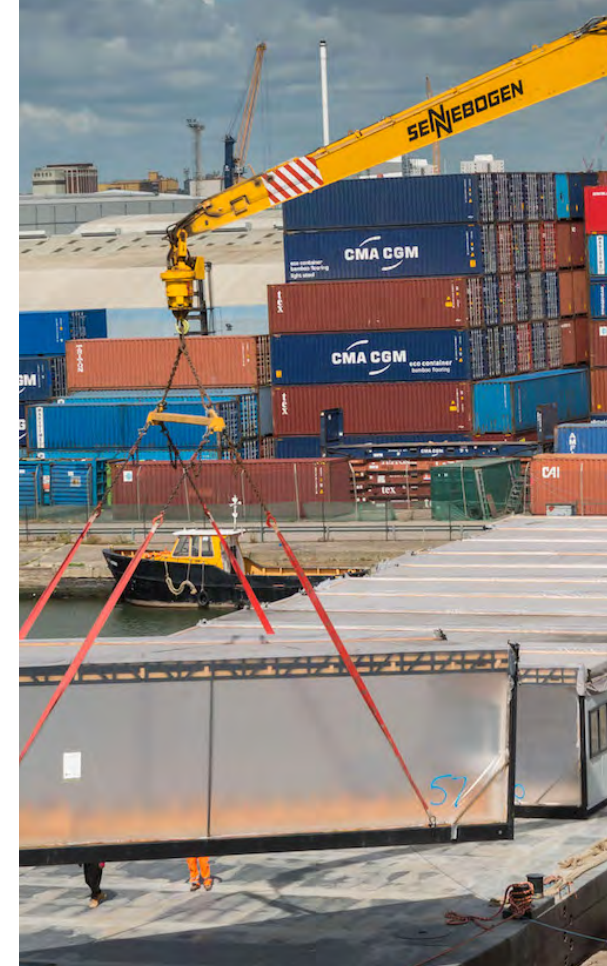

CASE STUDY

Thames Tideway Tunnel

We designed, manufactured and delivered a 3-storey off-site engineered office and welfare facility on behalf of the CVB Joint Venture at their Chambers Wharf Site.

In accordance with our Client's commitment to prioritise river transportation, all the off-site engineered sections and materials were delivered to site via pontoons on the River Thames, and offloaded directly from the pontoons onto site.

The building was designed to house approximately 140 Office Staff, and providing Welfare and Canteen Facilities for approximately 200 personnel, along with Occupational Health Facilities, Training Rooms, a Gym and Laundry CASE STUDY THAMES TIDEWAY Facilities.

Completed on budget and on time, resulting in Actiform being awarded a further 3 projects (Greenwich, Deptford and EARL Pumping Station) on this section of works.

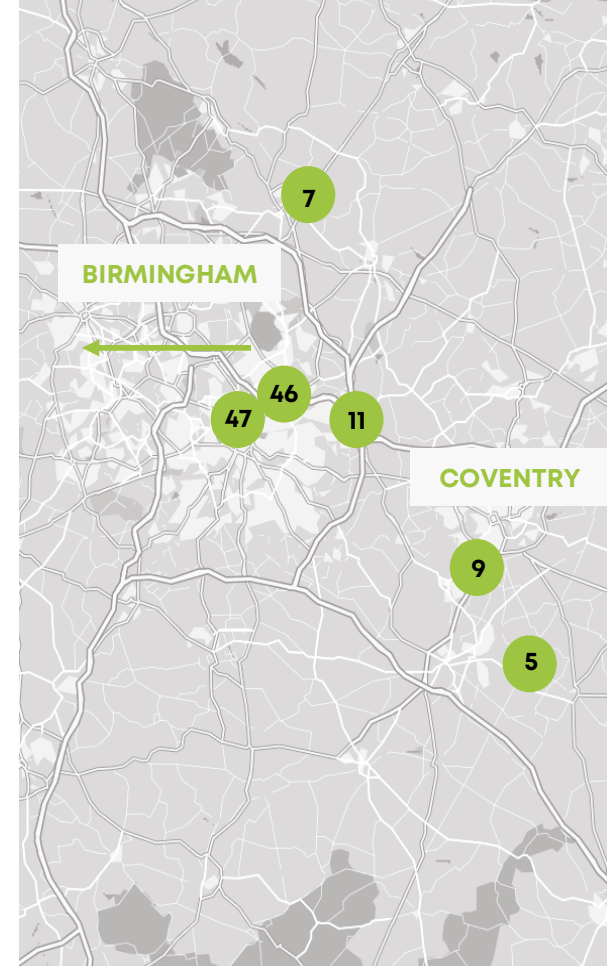
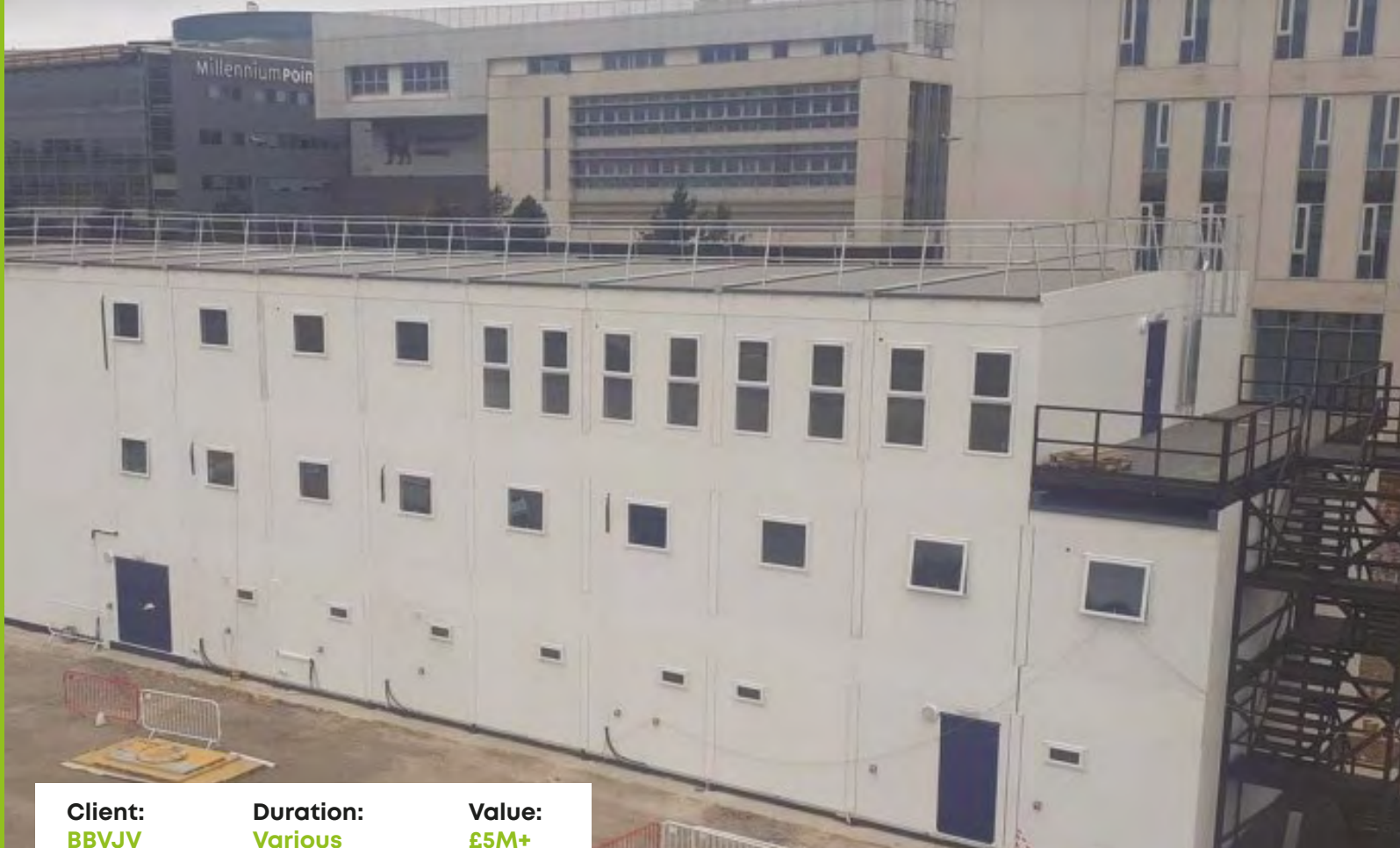

Crossrail

Crossrail is a new underground railway line being built in central London: 26 miles of tunnel will link Paddington in the west to Liverpool Street and Canary Wharf in the east, with connections to existing lines at either end permitting trains to Reading, Heathrow, Shenfield and Abbey Wood.

HS2

Building on longstanding experience we designed, manufactured and delivered a series of 2/3 storey off-site engineered office and welfare facilities to support the development of HS2.

Following a competitive tendering process Actiform were awarded the contract to design, manufacture and deliver multiple buildings for the Balfour Beatty Vinci JV section of the HS2 project.

All the buildings supplied on the project were designed in accordance with the HS2 BREEM guidelines.

Actiform have successfully installed a further 9x modular buildings on the HS2 project, including stores buildings, laboratory offices and training centres and have orders for a further 3 x single and multistorey modular buildings on this section of the HS2 project.

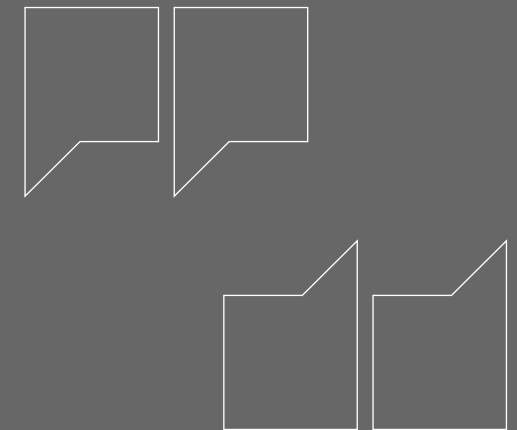
